This unique adhesive does not re-weld, offering a clean cut, and removal of kiss cut part from the release liner.

The ADMUC bonds exceptionally well to a variety of foams, including EPDM, polyolefin, neoprene, vinyl, and polyurethane, as well as common automotive substrates such as steel, ABS, PP, and TPO. In addition, the butyl provides superior resistance to extreme temperatures and has excellent low temperature flexibility and moisture resistance.
